

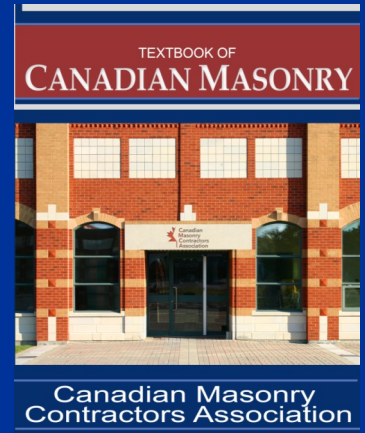
# TEXTBOOK OF CANADIAN MASONRY
